

E- Poster Award Category Guidelines

Please ensure that you adhere to the following instructions regarding the E- Poster Award Category

The abstract presenter **must register for the conference**. If you have not registered yet, please complete your registration at the earliest. Kindly ignore this message if you are already registered.

Unregistered presenters will not be permitted to present their abstract.

Submission Instructions:

- Presenting authors must submit their E- Poster to contact@rgcon2026delhi.com on or before 10th March 2026.
- Presentation must be prepared in Microsoft PowerPoint (PPT format only).
- Slides should be in 16:9 widescreen layout
- Each E-poster Must be presented as single or up to two slides only under the following headings:
 - **Case series:** Introduction, Objectives, Materials and methods, results, discussion, conclusion, references.
 - **Case report:** Introduction, Case Presentation, Discussion, Conclusion, references.
- The header of the slide(s) must mention: Title, Author names, and Affiliation. The presenting author's name should be underlined. Do not mention the institute name.
- We recommend a minimum font size of 50 pt. and more for the text.
- Use Times New Roman or Arial font style and plain background without pattern or dark colours.
- Presentations should not include any animated files, hyperlinks, or video clips as they will be non-functioning. Figures/images should preferably be added in a landscape setting.
- Figures, tables, and graphs (as applicable) must be labelled in order, followed by the description.
- For e-poster submission, please save the PowerPoint presentation as a PPTX file and rename the file as Your E Poster category and number, and mail the file as an attachment.
- All the information being presented is the full responsibility of the presenting author.
- The E-posters will be judged by an expert panel during the E-posters presentation session.
- Delegates will be allotted 3 minutes for presentation, followed by brief questions/discussion by the judges.
- Strict adherence to the time limit is mandatory to ensure smooth session transitions.

Important Notes

- Presenters must be present in the session hall at least 15 minutes before the session.
- The final presentation must correspond to the submitted abstract.
- Any major modification in data must be communicated to the Scientific Committee in advance.
